



## CITIZENS INVITED TO REVIEW AND COMMENT ON PLAN TO TEMPORARILY RELOCATE E-1 PRECINCT POLLING PLACE

**Montgomery County, Virginia** – Citizens may review and comment on Montgomery County’s proposal to temporarily relocate the E-1 Voting Precinct Polling Place from St. Michael Lutheran Church, 2308 Merrimac Road, Montgomery County, to Kipps Elementary School, 2801 Prices Fork Road, Blacksburg.

This move will take place once approval is granted by the U.S. Justice Department. The temporary relocation will only be for the June 12, 2012, primary election.

Copies of the County’s submission to the Department of Justice are available for public review at the County Government Center, 755 Roanoke St., Christiansburg, in the County Administrator’s Office (Suite 2E) or Public Information Office (Suite 2G). Office hours are 8:30 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday.
