MARRIAGE LICENSE KIOSK SIMPLIFIES TASK

Montgomery County, Virginia • A new self-service marriage license kiosk is now available at the Montgomery County Courthouse in Christiansburg. The kiosk will allow couples applying for marriage licenses to enter their own information.

“Simplicity is key; this will reduce customer wait time, produce less paper, use less staff time, and result in more efficient service,” Circuit Court Clerk Erica Williams said. “We are continually on the lookout for ways to improve customer service, and reduce costs to the county and state by implementing the use of technology.”



Marriage license applicants type their own information into a computer instead of filling out the traditional paper application and submitting it to a deputy clerk to be re-typed and printed. Persons applying for a marriage license need a valid government issued photo ID when they come. There is no change in the marriage license fee of \$30.

This is the first Clerk’s office in the 27th judicial circuit to implement this technology.
