



## CIRCUIT COURT CLERK'S OFFICE GETS \$10,000 GRANT

*Montgomery County, Virginia* – A \$10,000 Library of Virginia grant paid for the restoration of nine historical record books for the Montgomery County Circuit Court Clerk's office. These volumes include the County Muster Roll, the Register of Free Negroes and eight order books dating from the 1800s.

The restoration was performed by the C.W. Warthen Company.



“In these uncertain economic times, I am pleased to work in conjunction with the Library of Virginia securing grant funds at no cost to the citizens,” Williams said. “We were able to acquire \$10,000 to preserve and protect these valuable records of our history in Montgomery County – both now and for future generations.”
