### **Free H1N1 Flu Vaccine at New River Valley Health Departments and Community Sites**



The New River Health District (Virginia Department of Health) continues to offer H1N1 influenza vaccination at all area health departments and in numerous community locations.

“H1N1 flu activity may rise and fall, but it is expected to continue for several more months,” said Dr. Jody Hershey, Director of the New River Health District. “Vaccination is the first and most important step in protecting against H1N1.”

The H1N1 vaccine is always available free through your local health department. ***During the week of Feb. 8***, the vaccine is available as follows:

During normal business hours - to all walk-in clients, as well as those receiving any health department services - Monday through Friday, 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

During scheduled H1N1 clinics:

- Floyd County – Monday, Feb. 8, 1 to 3:30 p.m.; Tuesday, Feb. 9, 3:30 to 5:30 p.m.; Thursday, Feb. 11, 1 to 3:30 p.m.
- Giles County – Thursday, Feb. 11, 1 to 5 p.m.
- Montgomery County – Monday, Feb. 8, 8 a.m. to 12 p.m. and 1 to 5:30 p.m.; Tuesday, Feb. 9, 3 to 6 p.m.; Friday, Feb. 12, 1 to 3:30 p.m.
- Pulaski County – Thursday, Feb. 11, 2 to 5:30 p.m.
- Radford City – Monday, Feb. 8, 3 to 5 p.m.

During regularly-scheduled WIC clinics (Special Supplemental Nutrition Program for Women, Infants and Children):

- Montgomery County – Wednesday, Feb. 10, 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.; Thursday, Feb. 11, 12 p.m. to 8:30 p.m.
- Pulaski County – Tuesday, Feb. 9, 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.
