CERVICAL CANCER AT “WOMEN’S NIGHT OUT”**

(Christiansburg, Virginia) – The American Cancer Society’s New River Valley Breast Health Team is hosting Women’s Night Out. This fun and informative event will be held on Tuesday, Nov. 9, 2010, from 4 to 5:30 p.m. at the Floyd County Health Department in Floyd, Virginia. The event is free. Registration is requested, but not required.

Women of all ages are invited to enjoy light refreshments, free gifts, and women’s health information. During this event, low income, uninsured, and underinsured women who are 40 to 64 years of age may apply for the Every Woman’s Life (EWL) program or free mammograms through the Komen program. In addition to informing women of the importance of regular screenings, EWL provides free mammograms, clinical breast exams, Pap tests, and pelvic exams to women who qualify.
