A. SUBJECT: SHERIFF REQUEST FOR ONE-TIME FUNDING FOR IN-CAR CAMERAS AND BODY CAMERAS

BE IT RESOLVED, By the Board of Supervisors of Montgomery County, Virginia that the General Fund was granted an appropriation in addition to the annual appropriation for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2015, for the function and in the amount as follows:

Said resolution appropriates undesignated fund balance to cover the costs associated with in-car cameras and body cameras for the Sheriff's office.

ISSUE/PURPOSE: Funding for Sheriff in-car camera systems and body cameras.

JUSTIFICATION: The Sheriff requested funding to purchase 40 in-car camera and 52 body camera systems. The request includes 12 additional body cameras for SRO's and Investigators. These systems, including software, installation and a one year extended maintenance agreement will cost \$242,450.

The Sheriff received a letter from the Western Virginia Regional Jail dated October 16, indicating that the County will receive a credit in FY 15 of \$263,697. This credit resulted from the WVRJ ending the year with surplus funds and providing those funds back to the localities in the form of a credit toward the FY 15 billing. Based on the current expenditure trend, the year-end surplus is estimated at \$230,000. The WVRJ contributions will be monitored throughout the year to ensure sufficient funds are available to cover inmate billings. Additional funding for inmate billings will be addressed if the need arises.

The resolution appropriates fund balance to provide the remaining funds needed for camera systems.
