BE IT RESOLVED, By the Board of Supervisors of Montgomery County, Virginia that the General Fund was granted an appropriation in addition to the annual appropriation for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2014, for the function and in the amount as follows:

Said resolution appropriates monies received as part of the Forfeited Asset Sharing Program from the Department of Criminal Justice Services.

ISSUE/PURPOSE: Appropriate Forfeited Asset Sharing Program funds.

JUSTIFICATION: This money was seized from cases investigated by the Montgomery County Drug Task Force and prosecuted by the Commonwealth's Attorney's office as a participant of the Department of Criminal Justice Services' Forfeited Asset Sharing program. These funds must be used for law enforcement purposes only and may not be used to supplant existing funding.

2. SUBJECT: FIRE PROGRAM FUND ALLOCATION

BE IT RESOLVED, By the Board of Supervisors of Montgomery County, Virginia that the General Fund was granted an appropriation in addition to the annual appropriation for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2014 for the function and in the amount as follows:

Said resolution appropriates funds received from the Fire Program Fund for use by volunteer fire departments.

ISSUE/PURPOSE: Fire Program Funds.

JUSTIFICATION: Monies within the Fire Fund are provided by the Department of Fire Programs for the improvement of volunteer and salaried fire service operations in Counties, Cities and Towns. Funds are obtained from a 1% assessment levied by the state on insurance premiums. Monies provided by the County are distributed based on population in the unincorporated areas of the county that are served by each fire department. The population data is based on address points in each area as maintained in the County's GIS system. The proceeds for this resolution were received by the County on December 19, 2013 and consist of funds collected by the state for two fiscal years FY 13 (\$87,647) and FY 14 (\$77,702) for a total of \$165,349. Funds can be used for fire service training and the purchase of fire-fighting equipment. The distribution is as follows:

3. SUBJECT: HEALTH DEPARTMENT – TRANSFER FROM GENERAL CONTINGENCIES (Balance in General Contingencies before this Resolution is \$366,576)

BE IT RESOLVED, By the Board of Supervisors of Montgomery County, Virginia that a transfer of appropriation is hereby authorized, as follows:

FROM:

950 General Contingencies (\$28,126)

TO:

530 Public Health Department \$28,126

Said resolution transfers appropriated funds from General Contingencies to the Public Health Department for the County’s match requirement for state funding.

ISSUE/PURPOSE: Transfer of General Contingencies funds.

JUSTIFICATION: This resolution transfers \$28,126 from general contingencies to the Public Health Department to cover local match requirements. The Public Health Department is funded on a formula basis with costs shared between the state and the County. The County’s share is 38.3% and the state’s share is 61.7%. The State appropriated more for the County Health Department than anticipated in the FY 14 budget. The Health Department has \$12,615 provided by the County in FY 13 that was not used at year-end. Rather than refund the excess to the County, they are requesting to use those monies plus an additional \$28,126 to match state funds in the amount of \$65,599, making the FY 14 allocation \$505,881 in local dollars and \$814,543 in state dollars. According to the Health Director, funds will be used to fill a public health nurse position in Montgomery County. See TAB J.

4. SUBJECT: INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY

BE IT RESOLVED, By the Board of Supervisors of Montgomery County, Virginia that the General Fund was granted an appropriation in addition to the annual appropriation for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2014, for the function and in the amount as follows:

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The source of funds for the foregoing appropriation is as follows:

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Said resolution appropriates funds for the Finance System Consolidation Project between the County and the Schools and to upgrade Parks and Recreation's on-line registration system.

ISSUE/PURPOSE: Appropriate funds for the County/School Financial Systems Consolidation and the Parks and Recreation Department's on-line registration project.

JUSTIFICATION: This resolution appropriates funding for the one-time costs of consolidating financial systems between the County and the Schools System and upgrading the on-line registration system for Parks and Recreation. Currently, the County and Schools each maintain their own version of the same financial system, resulting in numerous inefficiencies. County and School staff and the County Technology Leadership Committee recommended the systems be combined into one consolidated system and database. Benefits include improved efficiency and reduced duplications of effort; more accurate data and more timely reporting; opportunities for consolidation of IT support of the system. The costs of the County/School Consolidation project are outlined below:

- License expansion, training, installation of modules for schools \$45,211
 - License expansion, training, installation of modules for County \$34,663
 - Services to Implement Consolidation \$81,338
 - Data Conversion \$31,400
- Total \$192,612

The Parks and Recreation Department’s on-line registration upgrade will provide a product that includes features enabling remote registration, automatic upgrades and marketing tools to integrate with e-mail and social media. The Technology Leadership Committee has also recommended funding for this project.

The estimated costs include:

- One-time implementation fee \$7,600
 - Equipment and annual fees \$2,400
- Total \$10,000

Said resolution appropriates funds from undesignated fund balance to cover the costs of improvements to Old Sourwood Road (SR 717).

ISSUE/ PURPOSE: Appropriate funds to cover the costs of improvements to Old Sourwood Road.

JUSTIFICATION:

In July of 2013, the Board of Supervisors appropriated \$175,000 for Old Sourwood Road improvements. This project is part of the VDOT revenue sharing program with 50% of the costs (\$87,500) coming from the state and an additional 50% (\$87,500) coming from the County. It was later determined that the actual cost of the road improvements would exceed the original estimates. On September 13, 2013, the Board of Supervisors approved a resolution requesting VDOT to transfer \$30,000 in remaining revenue sharing funds from the Craig’s Creek Road and Alleghany Springs Road projects to the Old Sourwood Road Revenue Sharing Project to cover the shortfall. This resolution appropriates those funds, which consist of a 50% local match (\$15,000) and 50% (\$15,000) in state revenue sharing funds.

Said resolution appropriates monies from an Office of the Attorney General (OAG) grant of federal asset forfeiture monies.

ISSUE/PURPOSE: Appropriation of grant funding received for the Sheriff’s Department.

JUSTIFICATION: This resolution appropriates monies from an Office of the Attorney General (OAG) grant of federal asset forfeiture monies. These funds will be used for the purchase of various types of public safety equipment for use by the Sheriff’s Office. There is no local match requirement and funding cannot be

used to supplant state or local funds but used to increase the amounts made available for law enforcement activities.

Said resolution appropriates recovered costs and asset forfeitures.

ISSUE/PURPOSE: Recovered costs and asset forfeitures.

JUSTIFICATION: Sheriff Security Services Recovered Costs (\$10,670): The Sheriff provides security services at local football and special sporting events. This resolution appropriates \$10,670 for these services.

Inmate Litter Control Recovered Costs (\$952): The Sheriff's office Inmate Litter pick up program is funded in two ways. The Sheriff's office contracts with VDOT contractors to pick up litter along the Route 460 by-pass and is reimbursed for this work. The County-funded portion of the program focuses on other roads within the County. Litter is not collected by VDOT on these roads. This resolution appropriates funds received (\$952) from the VDOT contractor.

Asset Forfeitures (\$5,425): This resolution also appropriates \$5,425 in monies seized in cases investigated by the Montgomery County Sheriff's Office and/or the Drug Task Force. These funds

must be used for law enforcement purposes only and may not be used to supplant existing funding.

WHEREAS, Richard W. Rentfrow and Kristi R. Rentfrow have requested the Montgomery County Board of Supervisors to vacate a lot line and a public utility and public drainage easement between lots 71 and 72 located in Phase 3 of the Indian Run Investment Company subdivision recorded in plat book 7, page 170 in the Montgomery County Circuit Court Clerk’s office, as shown more particularly on the Plat entitled “Plat of Boundary Line Vacation From Records of Tax Parcels 29-5-71 and 29-5-72 for Richard W.
