

PRE-INSPECTION REQUIREMENTS FOR POSTING PERMIT AT JOB SITE

1. **You must post your permit at the job site in a location clearly visible from the street. (USBC Section 110.5)**
2. **Inspections will not be performed unless permit is displayed and clearly visible from the street. If, at the time of the first inspection, you have not received your permit in the mail, you must still have the sign, with the 911 address, in place.**
3. Your permit must be posted on a minimum two feet (2') by two feet (2') sheet of plywood, which must be layed out in compliance with the standards shown in figure 1.
4. For manufactured house in mobile home parks, your permit must be placed either on a sign or in a window facing the street.
5. Plans that have been approved and stamped by Montgomery County Inspections shall be on site for use with ALL inspections (USBC 109.5)
6. If the site is not properly posted after the initial inspection, or if the approved plans are not available at ANY inspection, a re-inspection fee shall be charged.
