SUPPLIES

This year we have a new process for supply pickup. Join us at the Montgomery County Government Center lobby, 755 Roanoke Street, Christiansburg, to pick up your supplies:

- Tuesday, April 18, from 4:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m.
- Thursday, April 20, from 7:30 a.m. to 9:30 a.m.

When you pick up your supplies, provide the number of participants in your group and the t-shirt size for each person.

If you are unable to come by during these times let us know. We can work with you to make sure you receive your supplies in time for the big day.

- Montgomery County will provide gloves and bright orange trash bags for the event. Any additional items that may be desired must be provided by the individual or group participating.
- If possible, please return any unused supplies so they can be used again. The items can be dropped off at any of the ten consolidated waste sites in the county or they can be returned at Montgomery County General Services suite.

LITTER COLLECTION

HOURS Broomin' and Bloomin' collection will occur between **8 a.m. – 1 p.m.** In many cases, litter collection at the designated areas simply won't take the entire collection time period. Once your collection is complete, you are free to leave.

LITTER Please do not attempt to place large items in the refuse bags, such as tires. Larger items should be placed on top of full bags for post-event collection.

Safety first. Please do *not* handle/collect potentially hazardous items such as plastic bottles with suspicious substances inside (i.e. methamphetamine production paraphernalia) or medical waste (i.e. medical syringes and needles). If you come across items such as this during your collection, note where the item was found and contact Bill Long at (540) 250-7704 so the item(s) can be promptly investigated and properly disposed.

TRASH BAGS Leave all refuse bags behind for proper collection and disposal. Also, make sure all bags are closed. Tie all bags when they are full, or when a bag is partially full—if you are finished with collection—to prevent accidental spills and to keep wildlife out.

Do not dispose of any refuse bags at the Montgomery Regional Solid Waste Authority (MRSWA) or at the county's consolidated waste sites. The Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) or county employees will collect the bags from the collection areas for proper disposal after the event.

Place full bags along maintained roads or at an easily accessible location to ensure convenient and efficient collection.
