### Registration

Register at our office, by mail, by phone, or online. Our information is available at the bottom of the page.

**Please note** — Participants must register with the recreation department hosting the activity.

We reserve the right to have program flexibility.

### **Inclement Weather Policy**

Cancellations due to weather will be made by 8 a.m. the day of the activity. Call 540-382-6975, Option 2 for the cancellation line.

#### **Deadlines**

A deadline is set to secure tickets and program supplies. If the minimum number of participants is not met, an activity will be cancelled.

## Refunds—MCPR Policy

For a refund, cancellations must be made prior to the registration deadline listed under the program description, unless the vacancy can be filled from the wait list. Refunds are automatic if an activity is cancelled.

Please note — Due to the cost associated with credit card processing fees, we will no longer be able to issue refunds back to credit cards. Refunds will now be processed either by returning funds to your account for future use or via paper check, which will be issued within 10-14 business days.

#### Wait List

If an activity is full at the time of inquiry, individuals may be placed on the wait list. If a vacancy becomes available, participants will be notified.

#### Medicine

Participants should travel with at least a 24-hour supply of medication in the event of a delay on our return due to inclement weather or other circumstance.

#### **Pick-Up Location**

Participants may park in designated locations at the Montgomery County Government Center (MCGC) in Christiansburg. <u>Please arrive at least 10</u> minutes before departure.
