**General Information:**

- Garden (Sewer Deduct) meters may be purchased from the Montgomery County Public Service Authority to measure water used in outside areas that is not discharged into the sanitary sewer system. The water uses include watering of lawns and gardens, filling of swimming pools, car washing, and cleaning of outside building surfaces.
- The charge for the Garden Meter assembly is \$175.00. The Authority will not buy back or reimburse any portion of the meter cost. Garden Meters will not be sold to accounts that are delinquent.
- **The meter must be returned by the customer to the PSA Billing Office during the month of October for reading and calculation of sewer adjustment.** The only exception will be for a final account meter reading when the customer is closing out the water and sewer account. No adjustment will be provided for a delinquent account.
- Do not disassemble the meter or remove any parts of the meter assembly. Doing so will void this agreement.
- Attach your garden hose from the outside faucet to the inlet side of the meter assembly. Attach the hose end being used to the outlet side of the meter assembly. Use garden hose washers in the connections to the meter to prevent leakage.
- The meter should be secured to prevent damage from dropping or hitting other objects.
- Do not leave the meter assembly outside or in areas prone to freezing during winter/cold weather. Freezing will cause meter damage.
- The meter assembly will have a sixty (60) day warranty period from the date of purchase. The customer may return the meter assembly for evaluation and determination of cause of damage during the warranty period. Repairs or replacement of the meter assembly at no cost to the customer will be made by the Montgomery County Public Service Authority if damages are determined not to be from customer negligence. Repairs or replacement of the meter assembly will be the customer's responsibility if damages are determined to be the result of negligence or if not within the warranty period.
