

Medicare Part D Open Enrollment

It is time to think about your Medicare Part D Drug Plans again. Every January, all Medicare drug plans change. Even if you are happy with your current plan, you need to determine if it will still be the best one for you in 2025. If you fail to make a change during Open Enrollment, you may be stuck in a plan that doesn't work best for you next year. The NRV Agency on Aging VICAP Program will be assisting Medicare Beneficiaries beginning October 15th through December 7th. Call the Agency at 540-980-7720 to receive a form to fill out so that the VICAP staff can research the Medicare Part D plans that are available to you. If they find a plan that will better suit your needs, they will contact you, probably by phone as appointments aren't being scheduled this year as of now. During this contact, you can choose to make a change based on the information that the staff member presents to you. If they determine that your existing plan works for you in 2025, they will send you a "No Change" letter.
